



Things to Know When You Sign Up to Request Help

You are not guaranteed assistance. Help depends on if there is a Snow Angel who has signed up near you. UA CARES and the UA Commission on Aging works closely with the community to do the best volunteer recruitment and outreach we can.

We will notify you when you are matched with a volunteer by email or phone call

Once matched with a volunteer:

- You will be provided with the name and phone number of the volunteer.
- The volunteer will be provided with your name and phone number..
- It will be responsibility of you and your resident to communicate with each other to coordinate when shoveling will take place.
- Registration is on a rolling basis so a Snow Angel volunteer may be available later in the season.

Please remember:

- Give your volunteer a reasonable amount of time to assist you.
- Provide salt if you have requested that for your walkway or driveway.
- You do not need to be home when your Snow Angel arrives to help.
